Starting January 1, 2024, adults **ages 26–49** can enroll in full-scope Medi-Cal. That means individuals of all ages will now be potentially eligible for **full scope Medi-Cal**, regardless of immigration status, if they meet all other eligibility requirements.

What is Medi-Cal?

Medi-Cal is a public health insurance program which provides free or low-cost healthcare services to qualified California residents.

What does full scope Medi-Cal cover?

- Emergency healthcare
- Routine check-ups
- Medical, dental, mental health, family planning, and vision (eye) care
- Substance abuse treatment
- Prescriptions
- Transportation to and from doctor, dental, and pharmacy visits for prescription pick-up

Will receiving full scope Medi-Cal hurt my immigration status?

No, it will not. The U.S. Department of Homeland Security and U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services do NOT consider receiving health, food, and housing benefits as part of the public charge determination.
